

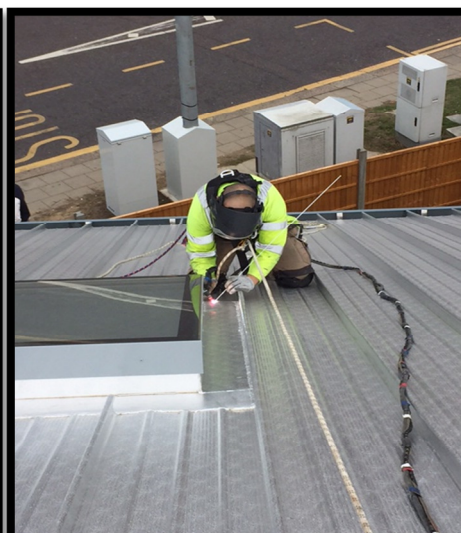


## PD23 ROPEED ACCESS



Roped access is required by M.R.(Site Services) Ltd to undertake works in accordance with HSG33 Health and Safety in roof work, a document produced by HSE, and Working at Height Regulation 2005 schedule 5, requirement for personal protection systems, regulations to cover all operations where so required for all M.R.(Site Services) Ltd products and services.

Roped access is used to carry out installations on Quantum Roof access products, annual inspections and maintenance or an installation service for Quantum aluminium site welding or the company's liquid applied system, Roll-a-Flex.
